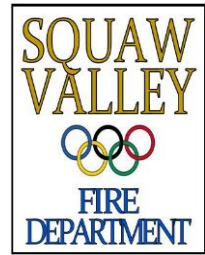

Liquidation of Surplus Property

SUBJECT: Surplus property

BACKGROUND: The Fire Department has an asset replacement program that funds the replacement of equipment and apparatus according to anticipated service life and/or industry guidelines. At present, the Fire Department has accumulated a significant stock of fire hose of varying sizes that have been replaced by new stock in accordance with our asset replacement program and NFPA guidelines. District code requires that the Board declare this asset to be surplus to our needs before it can be liquidated in any manner.

DISCUSSION: According to NFPA standards, this hose is "timed out" for our purposes, so there is an objective standard for declaring it surplus. Sierra College has a fire service training academy at their campus in Rocklin. That program has an ongoing need for fire hose and wears it out quickly. If your Board finds the replaced fire hose in our inventory to be surplus, some or all of it could be made available to the Sierra College training program, which would be grateful to receive it.

ALTERNATIVES: 1. Determine that the replaced fire hose is surplus to the District's needs and authorize the Fire Chief to donate it or dispose of it in some other manner.
2. Take no action.

FISCAL/RESOURCE IMPACTS: None - the replacement hose has been purchased and placed in service.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends Alternative #1 as described above.
