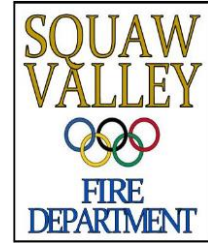

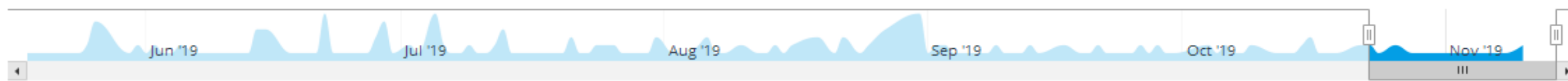
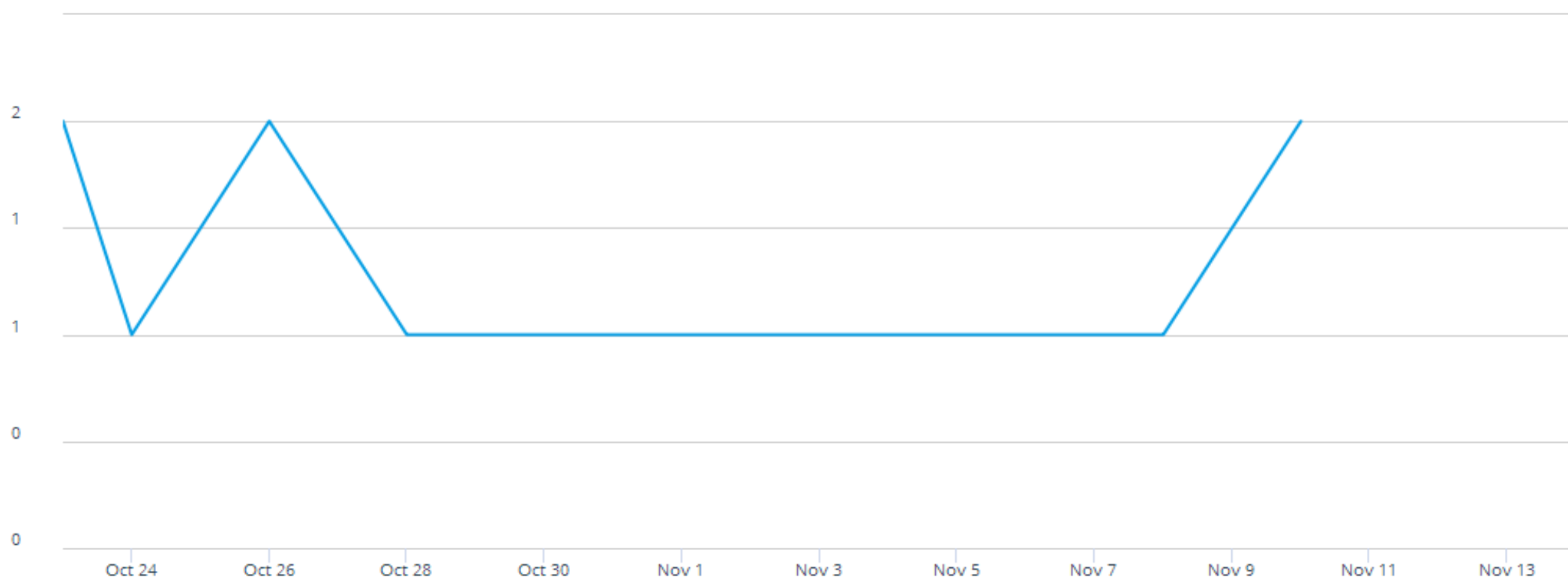

In Selected Time Slice

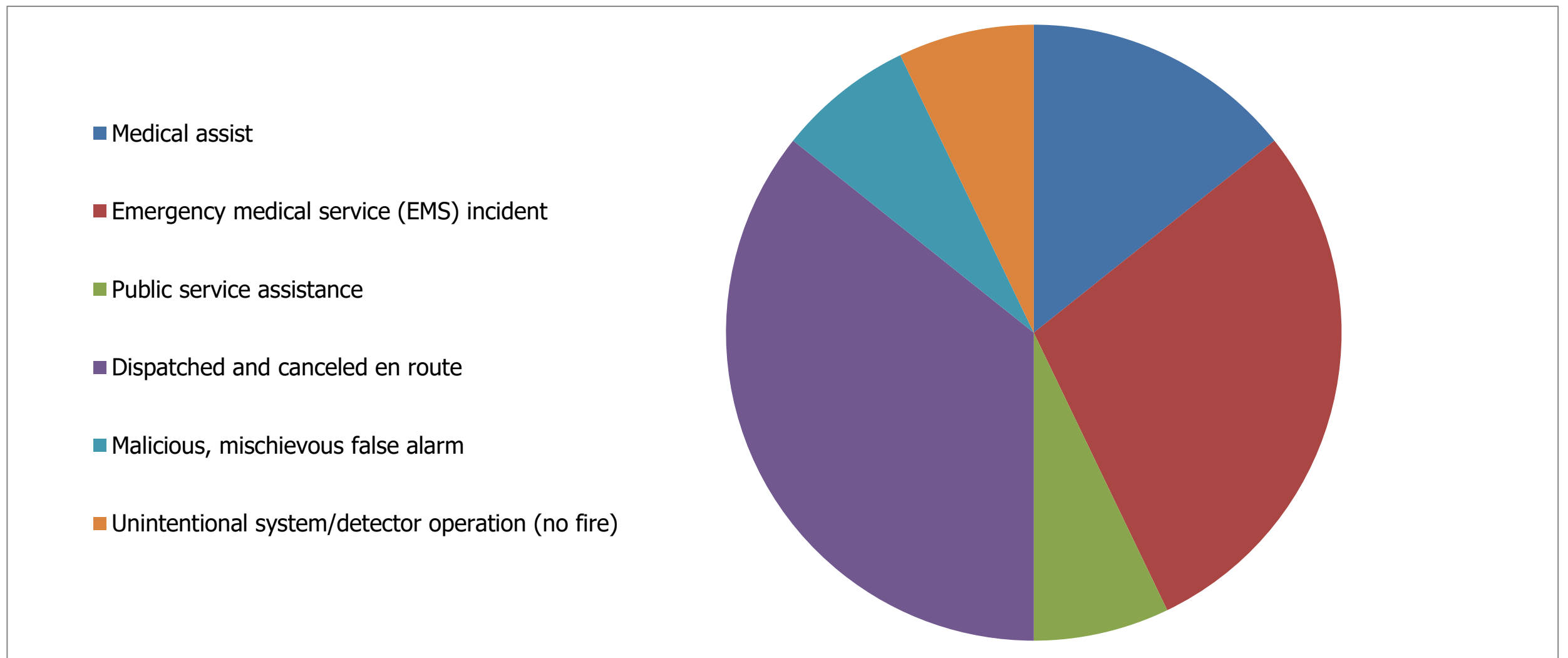

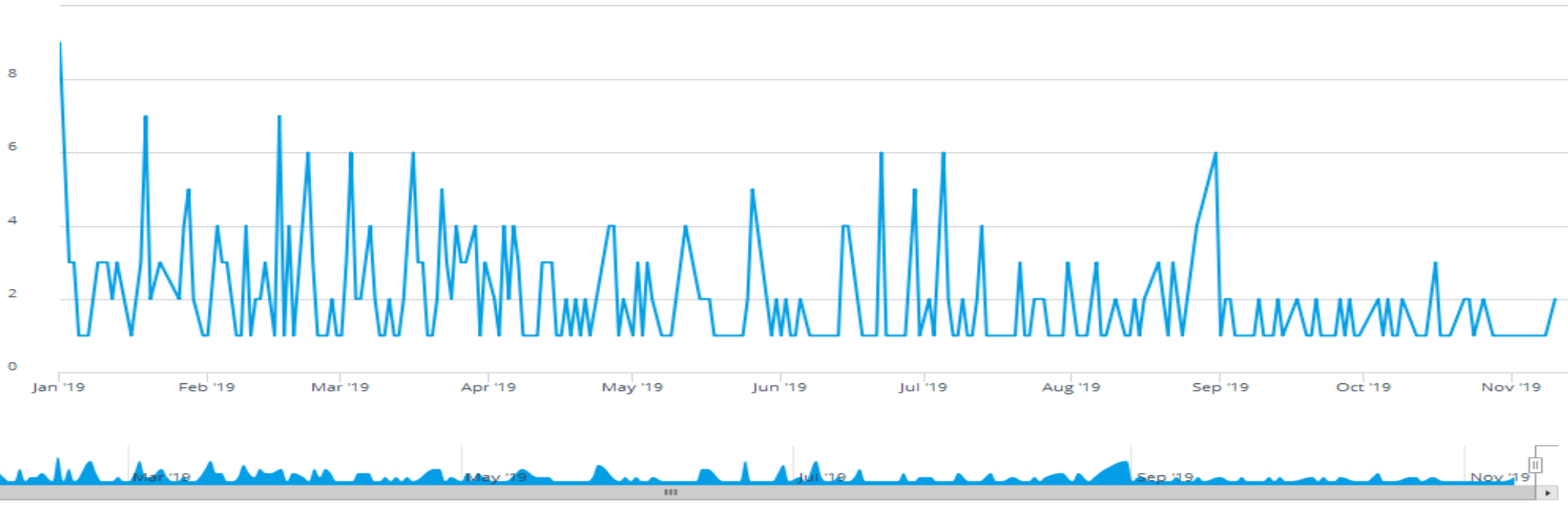
