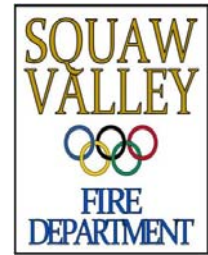

Squaw Valley North Waterline Replacement Project – Construction of the water system improvements at the Squaw Valley North condominiums was completed this month. The project was constructed by Al Pombo Construction and District staff provided construction

management and inspection services throughout the project. The project consisted of replacement of approximately 500 feet of asbestos concrete pipe water main and 13 galvanized steel services and meter boxes. The water meter boxes are now installed in a location accessible to the District.

With completion of the project, the District is expecting to take dedication of these facilities from the Squaw Valley North Condominium Owners Association sometime in early 2017. The District prepared a Water Line Replacement and Dedication Agreement for the project. The Agreement includes the terms for the District's reimbursement for a portion of the construction costs (\$14,500) to the Owners Association, and the infrastructure dedication and easement requirements. This information was presented to the Board at the August 2016 meeting.
