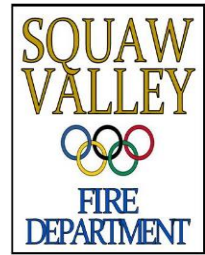

**PlumpJack Squaw Valley Inn Project** – Staff provided the County’s EIR consultant, Raney Planning & Management, with current design drawings for the District’s PlumpJack Well project which included an updated site plan and building elevations. The County will be using this information in their EIR Addendum for the project. The EIR Addendum will go to the Planning Commission for approval this fall/winter. Discussions with the developer’s representative indicate that they planning to begin construction of their project in May 2019. Upon approval of the EIR Addendum by the Planning Commission, the District will move forward with final design and permitting of PlumpJack Well Phase 2 – Well House and Equipping. It is the intention of the District to construct Phase 2 in 2019.
