Public hearings on the **PROPOSED** increases will be held on **May 31, 2016 and June 28, 2016** at **8:30 a.m.** by the District's Board of Directors at 305 Squaw Valley Road, Olympic Valley, CA. The <u>PROPOSED</u> rate increases will become effective **July 1, 2016**, if adopted. The new rates are proposed to increase revenue due to decreased water sales, increasing operating costs, funding of capital projects, replacement of equipment and infrastructure, and to ensure long-term financial stability. You may communicate your concerns by sending <u>written comments</u> to the Board of Directors, SVPSD, PO Box 2026, Olympic Valley CA 96146, or by delivering them in person at the hearings. Fax and e-mail submissions cannot be accepted. Property owners' protests must be received prior to the close of the public hearing on June 28, 2016. All protests must include a description of your property (parcel number or physical address), the type of rate protested, printed name AND signature. The person signing must appear on District billing records, or the Placer County Assessor's records, or other written evidence that the person signing has the authority to sign for the trust, company, partnership, etc. One protest per parcel and the parcel must have active water and/or sewer service. If you acquired the property since the last Placer County tax roll was issued, please include written confirmation that you presently own the property. If written protests against any of the proposed rate increases are presented by a majority of property owners and/or customers within the District's service boundary, the District will not impose that increase. In order to be considered, written protests must be received by the District prior to the close of the public hearings. The Board of Directors, after the close of the public hearings, will establish rates for 2016-2017, which rates and charges will not exceed the proposed increase set forth herein.
