## Adopt a Hydrant!

Maintaining winter access to fire hydrants is important and challenging. In Olympic Valley, access is generally maintained by the water purveyor, often with assistance from the Fire Department. Sometimes the job is overwhelming and requires identifying strategic hydrants until all can be cleared, often taking the better part of a week.

No permission or paperwork is necessary. When digging out a hydrant, please note that we need at least $24^{\prime \prime}$ clearance in all directions from the center of the hydrant.

While Hydrants are marked with snow stakes, please find the hydrant closest to your house before snowfall.
