ADOPTING AND AMENDING THE 2022 FIRE CODE SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE 2022-03

Ordinance 2022-03 was duly passed by the Olympic Valley Public Service District Board of Directors at a regular meeting held October 25, 2022 by the following vote on roll call: Ayes – Director Cox, Hudson, Hover-Smoot, Ilfeld, Smolen; Noes – 0; Absent – 0; Abstain – 0.

The Ordinance established revisions to the District's Administrative Code, Chapter 5 (Fire Prevention Code) which amend and adopt the 2022 California Fire Code. The revisions to the Fire Prevention Code are mostly technical in nature, changing how the Code references the California Fire and Building Codes as well as the NFPA Standards. The regulations create a higher safety standard required for climatic, geologic, and topographical differences in our District.

Ordinance 2022-03 was adopted following an introduction and reading of the Ordinance on September 27, 2022 and a reading and noticed public hearing on October 25, 2022. The revisions are effective once approved by Placer County Board of Supervisors and filed with the Department of Housing and Community Development.
