Seasonal Burn Ban in Effect as of 6/26/23

The Olympic Valley Fire Department has instituted the Seasonal Burn Ban for our District. The Burn Ban goes into effect on 6/26/23. The Burn Ban usually stays in effect until the severe threat of wildfire has dissipated or decreased to a point where the reduction in fire hazards favor lifting such ban. (Typically, sometime in the month of November.)

If you are a Short-Term Rental owner, your <u>renters</u> are banned from performing any of the below "banned" items 365 days of the year – regardless of the Burn Ban implementation.

When the Burn Ban is in effect, here is what is allowed and not allowed:

ALL FORMS OF OPEN FLAME ARE <u>PROHIBITED</u> DURING RED FLAGICRITICAL FIRE WEATHER CONDITIONS.

A red flag warning is the highest alert and is issued for weather events which may result in **extreme fire behavior**.
