

GREEN WASTE DISPOSAL

As of July 1, 2021, Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal (TTSD) will not collect green waste curbside. TTSD is facing increased disposal costs for green waste and operational challenges with mixed municipal and green waste. **Defensible space requirements have not changed**, below are some alternatives.

Program	Additional Cost to Customer
Self-Haul to Cabin Creek Road Facility	6 cubic yards or less: FREE More than 6 cubic yards: \$12.25/CY
One Week 6-Yard Dumpster Rental	\$129 Free with District Rebate
Green Waste Day (see below)	\$0
Hire a Defensible Space Contractor	Varies

- NO Household waste
- NO Hazardous materials

- NO Construction debris or building materials such as lumber, railroad ties, etc.



- Green Waste brought in plastic bags MUST be emptied. Please don't use bags if possible.
- If you need help bringing your green waste to the disposal site, we can help! Starting Friday, September 17th, you can reserve a time for someone to come to your house to pick up your green waste. Please call Mike Fenton at (775) 771-6424 to reserve your spot. First come, first served.
