Martis Valley Water for Squaw Valley?

What is the Issue? | Squaw Valley has been searching for a secondary water source and has identified Martis Valley as its best option for a redundant source. Squaw Valley Public Service District (SVPSD) has been looking for another water source for 25+ years. Conveniently the "need" for more water has surfaced during the planning process for Squaw's Village expansion project.

Why Should I Care? | SVPSD is claiming the redundant water source is not tied to the KSL Village expansion proposal. Is an 8-mile pipeline to transport water from Martis Valley to Squaw Valley, priced at \$30 million the answer to Squaw Valley's water issues? The answer is NO. Martis Valley ground water currently services the Truckee Donner Public Utility District, Northstar Community Services District and Placer County Water Agency. We believe that development must work within its constraints and not impact our natural resources for the sake of resort expansion.

How Can I Get Involved? | SVPSD is preparing a water assessment that will determine their current water yields and needs for the Valley; the assessment will be released soon.
