Procedures for Issuance of Residential Sewer and/or Water Permits

- 1) Owner/Contractor to email a set of plans to fgueissaz@svpsd.org for our records. Plans to include:
 - a. Site Plan (showing plot plan and location of sewer/water lines, size and location of propane tank, and location of secondary regulator)
 - b. Electrical Plan (showing smoke and carbon monoxide detectors)
 - c. Floor Plan (with plumbing fixtures)

Plans should show all fixtures to be connected to the sewer and water system. (We do not need Building Department approved set.) Please allow five business days for the Public Service District (including the Fire Department) to review plans calculate connection fees.

- 2) Owner/Contractor to include the following information via email submittal:
 - Property Owner Name
 - Owner Mailing Address
 - Owner Email Address
 - Applicant Name (if different than owner)
 - Applicant Mailing Address (if different than owner)
 - Applicant Email Address (if different than owner)
 - Street Address of Property
 - Building Permit Number
 - Description of Construction
- 3) District staff will review the plans and will provide the applicant with the fees owed within 5 business days. Payments can be made by credit card over the phone, or a check made payable to SVPSD can be mailed to P.O. Box 2026, Olympic Valley, CA 96146.
- 4) A copy of the completed Application will be e-mailed to applicant, and District staff will clear any holds with the Placer County Building Department.
