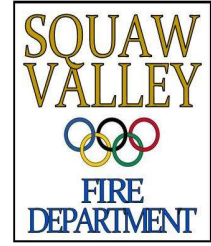

ADOPTING AND AMENDING THE 2019 FIRE CODE INCLUDING SUMMER CHARCOAL BAN SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE 2019-02

Ordinance 2019-02 was duly passed by the Squaw Valley Public Service District Board of Directors at a regular meeting held November 19, 2019 by the following vote on roll call: Ayes – Director Cox, Hudson, Mercer; Noes – Director Hover-Smoot, Ilfeld; Absent – 0; Abstain – 0.

The Ordinance established revisions to the District’s Administrative Code, Chapter 5 (Fire Prevention Code) which amend and, as amended, adopt the 2019 California Fire Code.

Revisions to the Fire Prevention Code include banning of open burning (including charcoal grills) during the summer; and changes to the regulations for open flame devices, automatic sprinkler systems, lock boxes, and gates on private roads.

Ordinance 2019-02 was adopted following an introduction and reading of the Ordinance on September 24, 2019 and a reading and noticed public hearing on November 19, 2019. The revisions are effective once approved by the County Board of Supervisors and filed with the Department of Housing and Community Development.
